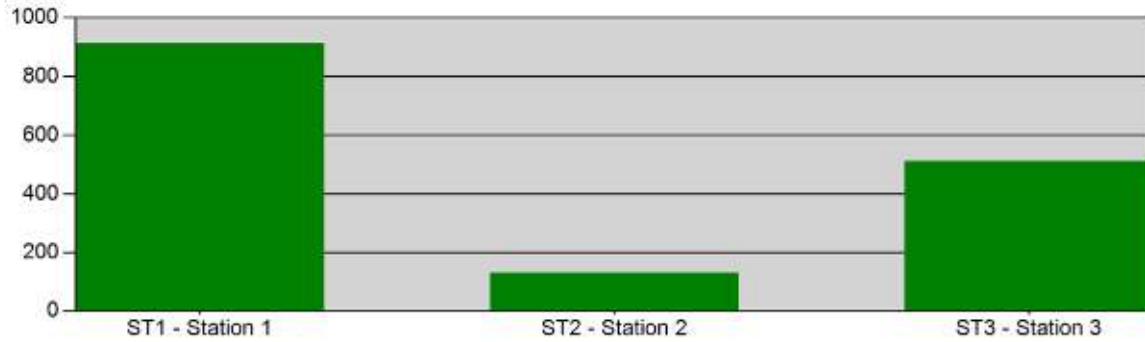

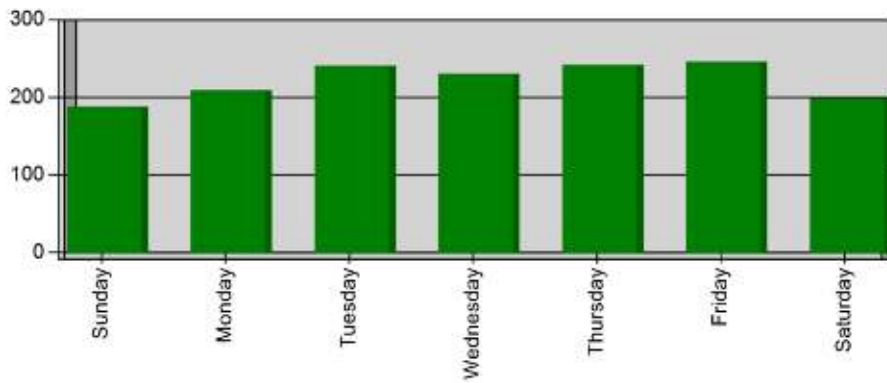

January Chief's Report

- *Training:*
 - Currently engaged with creating a training schedule for next quarter.
 - We are engaged in conducting an in-house Basic Fire Course for members.
 - Currently engaged with establishing EVOC dates to include burn tower dates as well.

- *Vehicle Maintenance:*
 - Currently, waiting on the parts to arrive to fix Squad 96 and Squad 97.
 - Squad 93 and Squad 96 have recalls for the potential for frames to cracks. I'm currently waiting on scheduling an appointment.
 - Engine 91 was towed to Central Power due to not starting. The shop replaced an eye on the starter.
 - Car 90 received an oil change.
